





What is a Coronavirus?

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses, most of which circulate among animals. Sometimes viruses jump to humans and can cause disease. A novel coronavirus, SARS-CoV-2, first identified in Wuhan, China caused a global outbreak of the disease named COVID-19.
