What is Heroin?

Heroin is made from **morphine**, a natural substance taken from the seed pod of **opium poppy plants** in Southeast and Southwest Asia, Mexico and Colombia. Heroin can be *injected*, *sniffed*, *snorted* or *smoked*.



The Connection between Opioids & Heroin

Heroin is a type of **opioid**. Just like other opioids, heroin binds to the **opioid receptors** in the brain and body causing the release of **dopamine**.

Heroin use has been **increasing**. The number of people using heroin has more than *doubled* in the past 15 years, to nearly one million in 2016.¹

20% of 12th graders said they could easily get heroin if they wanted to.2
