


CHARTS AND ILLUSTRATIONS

How do Charts and Illustrations Help You?

Charts and illustrations are special tools to help you find information easily. They are arranged in a way that puts all the information together so that it is clear and easy to read.

There are many types of charts and illustrations. Here are some you should know.

Bar graphs - colored lines called bars are shown so you can compare items. Look for the title of the graph, the key of symbols, the items being measured on the side, and the measurements along the top or bottom.



Maps and globes - models of areas on the land. Maps and globes help you locate places. They usually have a map key with symbols, and a series of lines called grids.

tallies. Every time the amount reaches 5, a diagonal line crosses 4 tallies to indicate 5. Then it is easy to count by fives to get the total.



A standard round clock face is a kind of chart. You can watch the short hour hand, long minute hand, and sometimes the second hand move around the clock. Remember the short hand only points to the numbers you see as they are the hours. The long hand is longer because

it is counting the minutes as it moves around the clock. If your clock has a second hand it is moving very quickly because it is counting the seconds.
