- Pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters are all forms of U.S. money.
- Penny

o The penny is copper colored.
o It has a picture of Abraham Lincoln.
o It is worth 14 (one cent).



## - Dime


o The dime is also silver, but is smaller than the other coins.
o It has a picture of Franklin Roosevelt.
o The dime is worth $10 \$$ (ten cents).

o The quarter is silver and much larger than the other coins.
o It has George Washington on one side.
o The quarter is worth 25 \$ (twenty-five cents).
