- Penny
 - The penny is copper colored.
 - It has a picture of Abraham Lincoln.
 - o It is worth 1¢ (one cent).

- The dime is also silver, but is smaller than the other coins.
- o It has a picture of Franklin Roosevelt.
- The dime is worth 10¢ (ten cents).









- The quarter is silver and much larger than the other coins.
- It has George Washington on one side.
- The quarter is worth 25¢ (twenty-five cents).








• When counting nickels, you can skip count by fives since they are worth 5¢ each.
