## SKIP COUNTING

## What is Skip Counting?

- Skip counting means you do not say every number as you count.
- You only count special numbers.
- There are many different ways to skip count.


## How to Skip Count:

- When counting by twos, you only say every second number.

$$
\begin{array}{llllllllll}
1 & \mathbf{2} & 3 & \mathbf{4} & 5 & \mathbf{6} & 7 & \mathbf{8} & 9 & \mathbf{1 0}
\end{array}
$$

In this case, you would only say the bold numbers. You skip the other numbers.
