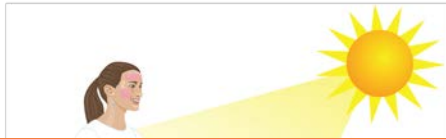


TEMPERATURE

What is Temperature?

- A thermometer is used to measure temperature.
- Temperature can be measured in degrees ($^{\circ}$) Fahrenheit.

How to tell the temperature:

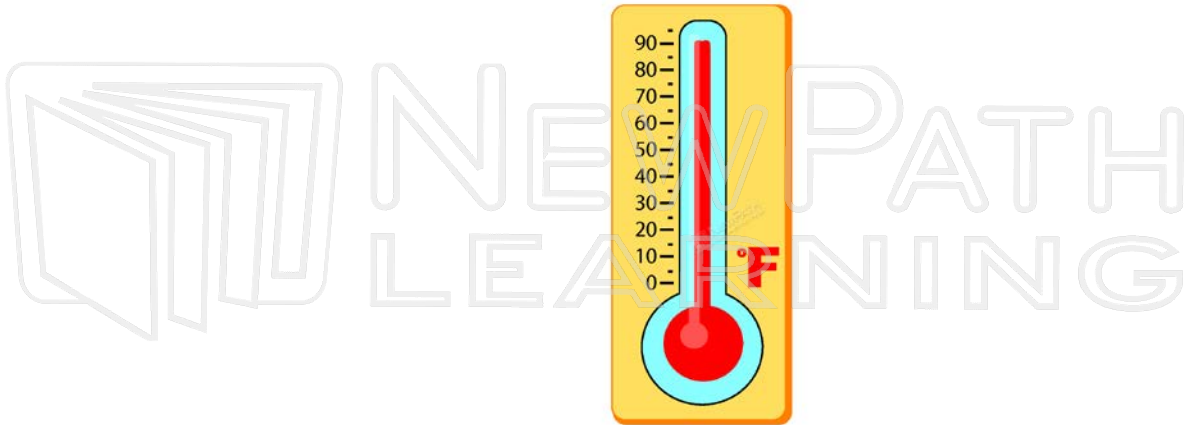

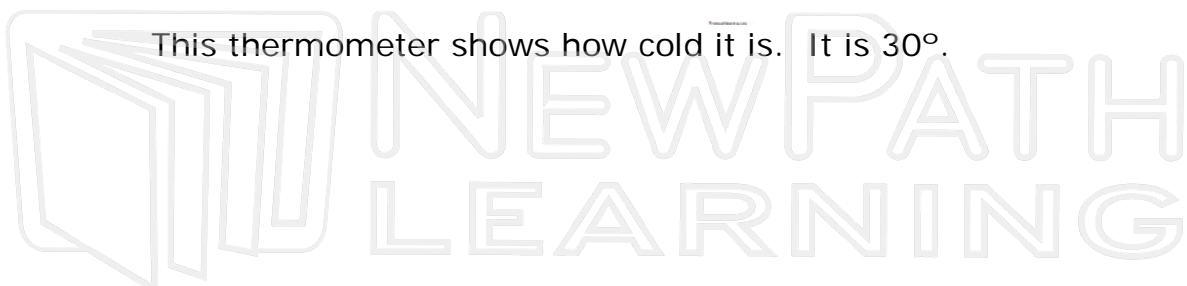


In this picture, you can tell it is cold from the snow and the person wearing clothes to keep warm.

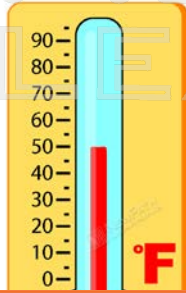
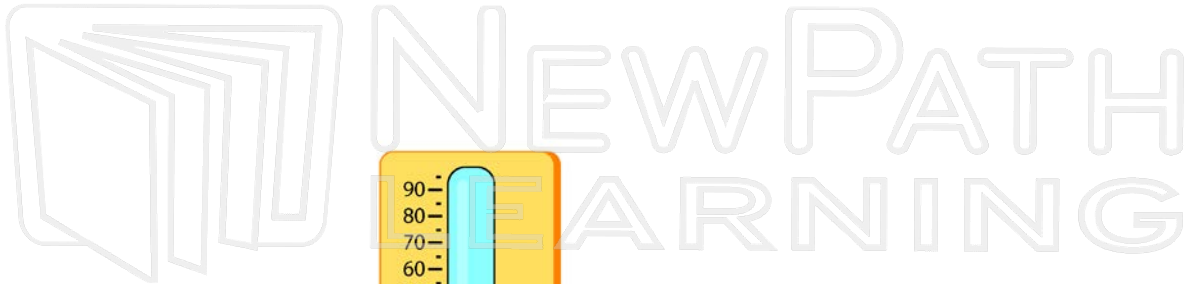

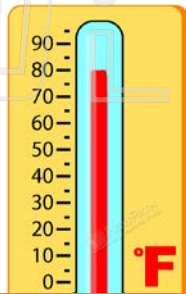
