On this calendar you can see:

Year = 2007

Month = August

Days in August = 31

You can also see other facts, such as:

August 8, 2007 is a Wednesday.

August 20, 2007 is a Monday.

Calendar Facts and Figures

One week = 7 days

1 year = 12 months

1 year = 365 days (366 days in a Leap Year)

January, March, May, July, August, October, and December all have 31 days.

April, June, September, and November all have 30 days.

February has 29 days (30 days during a Leap Year).
