The Earth is the third planet from the Sun.


Land and water cover the Earth but there is more water than land on Earth.

#### **The Four Seasons**

There are four seasons: winter, spring, summer, and fall.


#### What causes the seasons?

Earth is tilted and goes around the Sun in one year's time, so different places on Earth are closer and farther away from the Sun during different times of the year...causing us to have seasons on Earth.

Winter is the coldest season.




Summer is the warmest season.





Fall is when some areas leaves on trees change color and fall off.



Spring is when it starts to warm up after winter and new plants begin
