## What is the Senate?

The Senate is one of the two houses of Congress. The other house is the House of Representatives. Congress is the legislative branch of government. Congress meets in the Capitol Building in Washington, D.C. There are two senators from each state, with 100 total senators. Senators are elected by the voters in their state. Most senators are in one of the two main political parties-Republican or Democrat.

8. Listen to special interest groups and voters
9. Communicate with voters
10. Decide about taxes

There are many special names for people working in the Senate:

- Congressional page - young person who works for a Senator
- Majority leader - leader of the majority party
- Minority leader - leader of the minority party
- Whip - helps the floor leader keep in touch with the party
- President of the Senate - the vice president of the U.S.
