

EGYPT: (3000-1200 BC)

Ancient Egypt refers to the people and area surrounding the **Nile River** in Africa. This period of history called Ancient Egypt extends beyond the **3000 BC-1200 BC** era, but for this section we will be covering only this time.

During this time period, Ancient Egypt saw the rise of the **Early Dynastic Period** to the fall of the **New Kingdom**. Many things happened during those times, such as the creation of the **pyramids**, the creation of **paper**, and the growth of a writing system called **hieroglyphics**. Ancient Egyptians were very advanced in their architecture and societal structure.
