Drinking & Driving

Teen drivers are **3 times** more likely than experienced drivers to be in a **fatal crash**. Drinking **any** alcohol greatly increases this risk for teens.



Blood Alcohol Concentration

Driving Under the Influence (DUI) refers to operating a motor vehicle with a **Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC)** that is above the legal limit. In most states the limit is **0.08%**. (Utah's BAC was recently lowered to **0.05%**.) For people under 21, "**zero tolerance**" laws make it illegal to drive with **any** measurable amount of alcohol in their system.

- Never use a cell phone or text while driving.



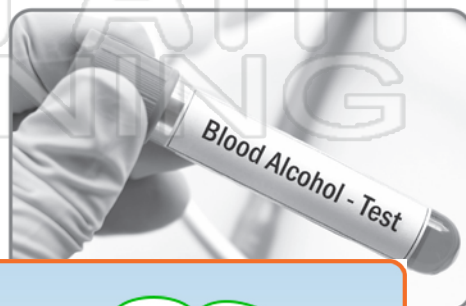
